BREATHING SPACE

Clear your mind and free your interior with a home design that maximises space and captures attention at just the right moments.

This small apartment favours bright white surfaces to maximise the sense of space, but it certainly strays from sterility. Texture is the trick, along with the power of strong base tones and accent colours. 'Carlotta' Oak Giovanni offers overall tonal consistency along with deep grooves and a dramatic straight grain texture. Creating a strong visual presence from a distance, Oak Giovanni also lures the eye with the delight of fine details that are best appreciated up close.









URBAN EDGE

Get creative and make an impact in tight spaces by mixing tones and being bold with shapes.

Studio apartments demand clever methods of spatial design to segregate areas without reducing their perceived depth. Here, a controlled creative approach sees bold shapes mixed with two shades of Oak Granada ('Darro' and 'Genil') for the creation of permeable screens. The saw-marked pattern and brushed effect bring an unexpected rustic undertone to the bold design. The lively swirling grain pattern, which feels as vivid as it looks, brings a refreshing and playful edge.

SIMPLY CALM

Enhance spaciousness with smart storage solutions that blend simplicity with a quietly expressive character.

There is a sense of restfulness to be found in clean lines and clear volumes. Facing sleek cabinetry and hidden compartments with an expressive surface material ensures banality is banished along with the clutter that can easily build up in a larger home. The Rosenheim Maple family offers a character that is both muted and eye catching. Its gentle timber tones and soft feel were inspired by the German winter, and are brought to life by swirling grains. Here, the 'Bleached' and 'Tanned' shades illustrate how a restful home can be quietly animated.







SOFTLY SPARTAN

Gently diffuse light without being blindingly bright using soft textures and pale tones in large volumes.

Generous volumes and plentiful daylight often go hand-in-hand in mezzanine apartments, and soft, pale colours are a smart way to bounce light all around the interior. To keep glare from disrupting your experience of such a well-illuminated space, it's important to avoid harsh reflections. Stoffa – an ultra-fine fabric design with a soft, powdery finish – has been used here in its 'Grigio' shade to gently inject colour and texture while diffusing light off its linen-like surface.
